How to use

- Bring the can to room temperature.
- Operating temperature 5° to 30°C.
- Shake can for 2 minutes before use.
- The surface should be clean and dry.
- Apply impregnation agent in several thin layers with an interval of 5 to 10 minutes.
- Dry for a hour, so that the effect enter.
